

Thank you for volunteering as an AAT Fosterer. This is an agreement between Animal Allies of Texas (hereafter referred to as AAT) and the person whose name, address and signature appear below (hereafter referred to as The Fosterer):

This agreement provides for the temporary care and accommodation of animal(s) rescued by AAT. AAT will be the sole owner of all animals being fostered, and fostered animals may not be handed over to any third party without prior approval of AAT.

AAT does not accept any liability in respect to damage to property or personal injury resulting from the fostering of animals under this agreement, and holds the rights to pursue legal recourse provided by the law if any harm, neglect, or abuse is inflicted upon the animal or animals in foster care. The foster does hereby release, discharge and hold harmless AAT from any claims or causes of action arising from fostering the animal(s).

The Fosterer agrees to provide temporary care for the animal(s) being entrusted into his/her care. The Fosterer agrees and undertakes to:

Provide strict attention to feeding, grooming, general care of all animals and to treat animals as a household pet and member of the family.

Notify an AAT representative of the need for routine or emergency veterinary attention and gain consent to such treatment before it commences.

Permit an AAT representative to do home visits at mutually convenient times.

Permit prospective owners to visit the animal at Fosterer's home if necessary.

Release any foster animal to an AAT representative or to a new owner upon request.

Report to an AAT representative without delay any accident or illness of a fostered animal.

Report to an AAT representative if a fostered animal goes missing for any reason.

Provide foster care until a suitable adoptive home is found for animal and take animal back if returned by adopter.

Agrees to take advantage of available opportunities for adoption that are appropriate for the Pet, including, but not limited to: making up-to-date bios and pictures available for posting, attending adoption events or making arrangements for pet to be transported to adoption events, placing cats in adoption cages, and other opportunities that may become available in the future

Promptly process any paperwork necessary for release or adoption of a fostered animal.

AAT agrees to:

Provide necessary veterinary care for fostered animal.

Provide heartworm and/or flea preventive and all supplies necessary for care of animal.

Either party may terminate this agreement. AAT is responsible for placing, within 15 days, any AAT fosters you deem you can no longer keep. An AAT foster is defined as any animal that AAT has placed with you.

Any animals that you bring into the program (strays you find, shelter pulls you opt to do, etc.) will become your responsibility if you default as a foster. AAT agrees to list the animals,

provide adoption venues, pay vet bills, grooming bills, and vacation boarding bills, but if you decide to stop fostering, you are financially responsible for repaying AAT for all bills, and finding another safe venue for the animal. AAT will attempt to assist you in placing the animal, but will not guarantee placement. If your foster is returned within 6 months of it's adoption, you also agree to take the pet back as a foster. If you are not prepared to agree to these terms and honor your commitment until a permanent home is found for an animal, please rethink fostering!
